Since we like Supplier B's quality, apply a \$500 bonus to that supplier's bids (the system will then use the adjusted bid value in determining allocations).
Proportionate Bid Adjustment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Apply a positive bonus to selected bids. Apply a negative malus to selected bids. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Specify the 'Proportionate Bonus'. Can be applied to all bidders, select bidders, or a custom bidder group. Can be applied to all lots, select lots, or a custom lot group. 	Since we like Supplier B's quality, apply a 2% bonus to that supplier's bids (the system will then reduce Supplier B's bids by 2% just for analysis purposes; the actual cost remains the same).

Optional Lot Award (Award an exact number of lots)	Enter the number of lots awarded.	Can be applied to all bidders, select bidders, or a custom bidder group. Can be applied to all lots, select lots, or a custom lot group.	This is useful for considering alternate bids - e.g. from Lot 1 or Lot 2, award just one.
